What is Echocardiography?

Echocardiography uses ultrasound waves to create the image of your heart and its function, which we are able to measure and check non-invasively. It is safe, accurate and requires no preparation or fasting for the procedure. A transthoracic echocardiogram carries no risks. We will require access to your chest.

Our tests are performed by highly skilled, experienced, accredited and compassionate technicians who are familiar with children.

What is ECG?

ECG (Electrocardiogram) measures the electrical rhythm of the heart by attaching 10 stickers to the chest. This takes 5-10 minutes and gives us a digital reading.

What is Holter Monitor?

Holter Monitor – This little box attached to 5 stickers on your chest will record the electrical activity of your heart for 24 hours. You will be able to do most of your normal daily activities, including sports. The only limitation is not to get the monitor wet (i.e. No shower, bath or swimming). It takes 10-15 minutes to attach.
